Even before ENSAT had been officially founded in 2002 annually scheduled meetings for scientific exchange have been a core activity of ENSAT. Over the years the meeting has considerably grown and can now be considered as one of the most important international conference that covers all aspects of pathophysiology, and basic, translational and clinical studies in the field of adrenal tumours

Following its tradition the meeting is divided into oral presentations according to the four working groups: Adrenocortical carcinoma (ACC), Pheochromocytoma/Paraganglioma (PCC/PGL), Aldosterone producing adenoma (APA) and Non-Aldosterone producing adenoma (NAPACA). Oral communications which will be selected on the basis of their scientific quality by an expert panel are followed by working group meetings. During those, proposals for new project can be presented and follow-up information on ongoing work be provided. Investigators will further have the opportunity to present their most recent data as posters during a guided tour. Plenty of time is reserved for discussion.

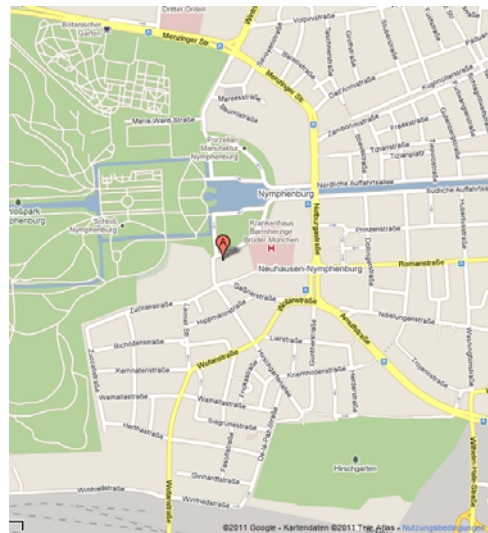

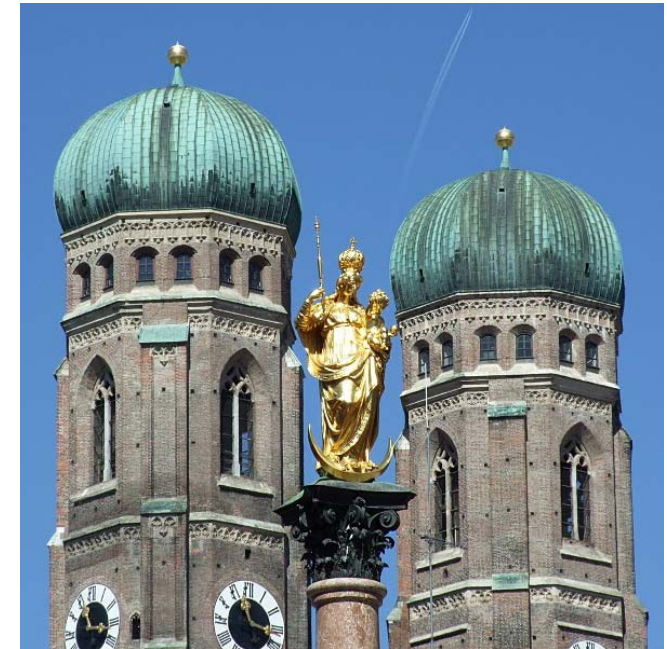
